Conference with experts and professionals

Focus on the relation between electric mobility and energy storage, a new concept for the energy management, developed within AlpStore project

Brescia, September 15th, 2014 – ALOT, Agency of East Lombardy for Transport and Logistics, presents a public event. The event involves experts, project partners, companies active in the fields of renewable energies, electric mobility, managing of energy sources, energy supply.

The meeting will run on **October the 1st, from 9 am till 1 pm at NOVOTEL's Conference Center, via Pietro Nenni 22, Brescia, Italy**. The event has been developed within the project *AlpStore - Energy Storage for the Alpine Space*, started on 2008, which is carrying on studies and field-tests related to the energetic potentialities of renewable energies, in 5 Alpine Space countries, especially regarding the mobility and the way the electric vehicles could be used as energy storage systems, making the offer of renewables sources stable (as they are not naturally constant).

During the meeting the AlpStore project will be presented together with its field-tests the partners are developing, especially the ones that are studying the energy storage combined with the electric mobility in Italy (Brescia, Mantova, Legnano, Aosta).

The convention, public with a required [registration](#), is specially addressed to companies active in the fields above mentioned, public administrations, professionals and experts belonging to supply chain of electric vehicle – charging network – energy storage technologies.

In the afternoon will take place the Evaluation Workshop WP7, a workshop reserved for project partners and experts, aiming to assess the costs-benefits relation and to evaluate the territorial feedback regarding the AlpStore's pilot actions.
